
What is the Idea Behind the Project?



How do we do it?

The EntRENEW project has developed a trans-disciplinary HE blended-learning course in Entrepreneurship in Renewable Energy (ERE) at the intersection of entrepreneurship and technology. Designed for students in Entrepreneurship & Economics and Energy Engineering, it will be incorporated within existing Master programmes of the partner organizations.






